



JOSEPH JULIANO APPOINTED TOWN COUNCILMAN

The first order of business for the Schuyler Town Council at their September 14th Town Board Meeting was to appoint Town resident Joseph (“Joe”) Juliano to fill the vacant seat on the Town Board for the remainder of the 2017 calendar year.

Following administration of the Oath of Office by Hon. George Luther II, Councilman Juliano was seated at the Board and assumed all duties of the Office of Town Councilman. Councilman Juliano will be running unopposed on the People’s Voice (Independent) line in the November General Election to fill the vacant seat on the Town Board for the remaining 2 years of this term. He will be running unopposed on the People’s Voice (Independent) ticket in the November 7th General Election to fill this vacant seat for a 4-year term of office.

Joe and his wife and family operate Juliano’s Farm Market, a successful new business located on State Route 5 in Schuyler.
