Shall the proposed amendment be approved?</p> <p>YES <input type="radio"/> NO <input type="radio"/></p>	<p><b>PROPOSAL NUMBER THREE, AN AMENDMENT</b></p> <p>Authorizing the Use of Forest Preserve Land for Specified Purposes</p> <p>The proposed amendment will create a land account with up to 250 acres of forest preserve land eligible for use by towns, villages, and counties that have no viable alternative to using forest preserve land to address specific public health and safety concerns; as a substitute for the land removed from the forest preserve, another 250 acres of land, will be added to the forest preserve, subject to legislative approval. The proposed amendment also will allow bicycle trails and certain public utility lines to be located within the width of specified highways that cross the forest preserve while minimizing removal of trees and vegetation. **HOW TO VOTE**

1. Mark in pen or pencil.
2. To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot fill in the  to the right of the candidate's name, like:
3. To vote for a person whose name is not imprinted on this ballot write or stamp the name in the blank space which appears at the bottom of the column under the title of the office.
4. To vote on a proposal fill in the  in one of the squares contained in the box setting forth such proposal, like:
5. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting oval or blank spaces provided for voting will void this entire ballot.
6. The ballot of the absentee voter must be postmarked not later than the day before election and received by the Herkimer County Board of Elections not later than 7 days following the day of election to be cast and counted.
7. Do not overvote. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your ballot will be void for that public office, party position or proposal.
8. If you tear, or deface, or wrongly mark this ballot, call the Board of Elections at (315) 867-1102 for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making erasures or cross outs. Erasures or cross outs may invalidate all or part of your ballot. Prior to submitting your ballot, if you make a mistake in completing the ballot or wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot upon return of the original ballot.
