MINUTES OF AUGUST 10, 2016: Motion by Szesny, second by Anthony Lucenti, that the Town Board dispenses with the reading of the minutes of August 10, 2016 and approves them as printed; all in favor.

PAY BILLS: Motion by Szesny, second by Robert VanDusen, that the bills for the past month be paid as presented General # 309 to 364 and Highway # 1471 to 153; all in favor.

RESIDENT COMMENT: A town resident had a complaint regarding the house located at 2066 State Route 5. She said they are always having parties and she has called the State Troopers numerous times and the residents must have a scanner and know the State Troopers are coming and then quiet down. She asked the Town Board what they can do about the situation that there was a previous complaint, months ago. Councilmen Lucenti, said what has to be done, is the Town would have to purchase monitoring machine for noise, have someone trained on it, and hire someone to run it. Then a Local Law for Nuisance would have to be filed with the State of New York. He said it can be a costly venture. Codes Officer Philip Green said the machine would have to be tested every three months. He then said after some many complaints the owner of the house would be notified and then pulled into Court and then it would be up to the Judge to shut them down.

Town Resident Harry Robbins said at the 9/13/2016 primary, it was a good turnout. Mr. Robbins said 20% of the voters turned out.

TOWN CLERK REQUEST FROM EARL RE: WEST SCHUYLER CEMETERY: The Town Clerk said she received a request for "No Parking Anytime Signs" in front of the West Schuyler Cemetery. She said Mr. Haman said he had a funeral and both sides of the road were parked cars for the funeral. He said it is dangerous especially with traffic up and down Newport Road.
