The Village of Ilion has contacted the Mohawk Valley Water Authority to inquire if a water line extension could be built through the Town of Schuyler to Ilion. The Schuyler Town Board has been asked if property owners along the proposed line would have any interest in establishing a water district, or if the line should just focus on Ilion's water needs.
